- Designed to encourage the children of California to READ, READ, READ!
- Promotes recreational reading of popular literature; books by a living author and published within the last 4 years
- Students, teachers, librarians, and parents may recommend books
- The CYRM committee reads all recommended books and selects a well-balanced list for each category
- There are five categories: Picture Book, Picture Books for Older Readers, Intermediate, Middle School, and Young Adult; students must read all books in a category to be eligible to vote




## Bluefish

- Have students learn more about reading disabilities
- Challenge students rewrite a chapter from a different perspective




## Chained

- A 10-year old boy in India takes a job as an elephant keeper to pay the hospital bills for his sister
- Engage children in a discussion of when to take action after witnessing abuse
- Learn more about the treatment of animals in circuses today



## The False Prince

- O Author: Jennifer A. Nielsen
- Three orphans are trained to impersonate a long-lost prince to unify a kingdom
- Discuss the qualities needed for a leader and the dangers of competition
- Learn more about the Middle Ages and monarchies




## Daughter of Smoke and Bone

- Have students create monster and angel sketchbooks
- Discuss wishes and languages




## The Fault in Our Stars

- Author: John Green
- Two teens who have had or have cancer fall in love
- Have students share favorite books and cities they'd like to visit
- Compare the two characters and their approach to life, love, and death
- Discuss how to live life to the fullest daily

- A military prodigy and the most wanted criminal fall in love in a future society
- Discuss when and how rebellion is justified and demanded
- Research plagues of the past and discuss the dangers of an introduced plague
